



T.D.ALLMAN SCHOLARSHIPS, TRAVEL GRANTS AND FELLOWSHIPS
FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2012-13

St. Antony's College, Oxford, is pleased to offer the T.D. Allman Scholarships and Travel Grants. These are tenable at the College for the academic year 2012-13 only. Criteria for selection will include the academic merit of the work proposed, the candidate's financial need, and the anticipated contributions to society and to broader social understanding of the study to be undertaken. The following are available:

- **Field work and research grants of up to £2,500**
- **Scholarships of £4,000/£5,000 for students in one, two or three-year degree courses for 2012-13.**

The grants and scholarships are available to any of the following categories of students:

- students who are working toward post-graduate taught degrees at St. Antony's (or who will be in 2012-13) and are studying Chinese affairs;
or
- students who are carrying out research on China: **or**
- students who are citizens of the People's Republic of China.

All applicants should submit a proposed plan of study/research, a current cv, a statement of other funding already in hand or anticipated, and the names of two referees. In the case of those applying for field work and research grants, please also include a budget. Recipients will be expected to provide a report on their activities at the end of their tenure of the scholarships, grants or fellowships.
