



SWIRE/CATHAY PACIFIC SCHOLARSHIPS

TENABLE AT ST. ANTONY'S COLLEGE, OXFORD UNIVERSITY

Two scholarships for postgraduate students tenable at St. Antony's College, Oxford have been established under The Swire Educational Trust by John Swire & Sons for permanent residents of Hong Kong.

1. The scholarships are known as Swire/Cathay Pacific Scholarships and are awarded annually.
2. Each scholarship is tenable for up to four years, depending on the course undertaken and subject to satisfactory academic progress, and is currently to the value of **£14,100** per annum (this amount is paid to each scholar) plus the full cost of the scholar's university and college fees. Free economy class air passages to and from London are provided to the scholar at the beginning and at the end of the period of tenure. It is expected that the scholars will reside in Oxford throughout each academic year, except for short periods of fieldwork which may involve study in another country.
3. The scholarships will be awarded to permanent residents of Hong Kong who have completed the majority of their formal education in Hong Kong. Applicants should normally be graduates of not more than four years standing who intend to return to Hong Kong to pursue a career in business, Government, academic life, or in a recognised profession. Undergraduates in their final year and sitting for their degree may also apply.
4. The scholarships are intended primarily for students who wish to read for higher degrees in the **Humanities and Social Sciences, including but not confined to, Development Studies, Economics, Modern History, Politics, International Relations, and Social Anthropology**. Other degrees that are eligible include those that draw on the area studies expertise found within the College. A full list is available in the University's Graduate Studies Prospectus available on the web or in hard copy.

5. Applicants must have applied for their chosen course of study and College place by the University's deadline of **20th January 2012**. The deadline for application to these scholarships, tenable only at St. Antony's College, is 31st March 2012.
