### STUDENTSHIPS

The Middle East Centre is pleased to invite applications for the Pachachi Doctoral Studentship for the 2011-12 academic year. The Pachachi Studentship is available to continuing doctoral students working on the modern history (broadly defined) and the social sciences of the Arab world.

Guidelines for applications to the Pachachi Studentship are as follows:

1. Only *ongoing* students (i.e. already admitted and working toward a DPhil in the current academic year) are eligible.
2. The studentship is for one year, but recipients of the studentship may apply again in subsequent years.
5. The Studentship may not be held concurrently with other major awards such as the AHRC Doctoral Award or Clarendon Bursary.

The award will be made on the basis of academic excellence, though preference may be shown for candidates with demonstrated need, without regard to nationality. All applications will receive equal consideration regardless of college affiliation at the time of application, though a successful candidate from outside St. Antony's will be required to transfer to St Antony's College at the time of taking up the award. The value of the Pachachi Studentship in 2011/12 will be £7,000.

Applications should include the following:

1. current curriculum vita
2. brief statement detailing any currently-held studentships, and listing all forms of support for which you have applied this year.
3. letter of reference from the thesis supervisor
4. thesis proposal of no more than 1,500 words in length.
