Born 13 July 1917. Educated Stowe; Christ Church, Oxford. Commissioned 2nd Middx Yeomanry, 1939; served in Middle East and Greece. Joined Foreign Office, 1946; served Athens, 1946-48; Jerusalem, 1948; Foreign Office, 1948-50; Baghdad, 1950-1953; Foreign Office, 1953-58; Tunis, 1958-1962; Algiers, 1962-1963; Foreign Office, 1964-1965; Head of Information Research Dept., FCO, 1966-1969; Adviser to Secretary-General of OECD, 1970-80. Married, 1949, Maria Jeanne Tambakopoulou. Died 2001.

Scope and content: Photocopies of fragments of a diary kept April-June, 1948 in Palestine; situation reports from Haifa, etc. dated June, 1948; letter, 23 October 1976, outlining his Palestine connection.
