Biographical history: Furness, Sir Robert Allason (1883-1954)

Born 1883, son of Revd. and Mrs. John Monteith Furness. Educated Rugby School; King's College, Cambridge. Entered Egyptian Civil Service, 1906; Deputy Chief Press Censor, 1914; Director of Imports and Exports, War Trade Dept, 1917; P.A. to Financial Adviser, 1919; seconded to staff of High Commissioner for Egypt, 1919; retired from Egyptian Civil Service, 1923; Oriental Secretary to High Commissioner, 1923-26; CBE 1926; Deputy Director-General, Egyptian State Broadcasting, 1933-34; Press Officer, Government of Palestine, 1934-36; Professor of English, Fuad I University, Cairo, 1936-44; Deputy Chief Censor of Publications, Anglo-Egyptian Censorship, 1939-44; CMG 1944; British Council representative in Egypt, 1945-50. KBE, 1951. Married, 1945, Joyce Marc - one daughter, Mary. Died 4 December 1954.

Scope and content: Papers relating to Anglo-Egyptian relations, English teaching at secondary school and university level, the formation of the Anglo-Egyptian Union, and censorship in Egypt.

System of arrangement: Largely as received.

Access conditions: Open

Language of material: English, French, Arabic

Conditions governing reproduction: No restrictions on copying or quotation apart from statutory regulations and preservation concerns.

Custodial history: In the possession of Sir Robin and Lady Furness.

Immediate source of acquisition: Received from Lady Furness at intervals between 1980 and 1985.
