Scope and content: Papers relating to the administration of Palestine Railways and Ports, 1923-48, including reports on sabotage; development of railways in the Middle East, 1882-1946. Photograph collection.

System of arrangement: Administration of Palestine Railways and Ports; historical development of railways in the Middle East; pamphlets etc. unconnected with railways; maps
