## Global Thinkers of the International: Jawaharlal Nehru on International Relations

In the final session of the Global Thinkers of the International Discussion Series, Oxford, join Professor Judith Brown to discuss the international thought of India's first Prime Minister Jawaharlal Nehru. Professor Brown has written a biography on Nehru, titled '*Nehru: A Political Life*', which was published by Yale University Press.

After India's independence, Nehru became the virtual director of its foreign policy. His policies of non-alignment and Panchsheel—the five principles of peaceful coexistence—guided India's international relations until the outbreak of the Sino-Indian War in 1962, which contributed to his declining health and subsequent death in 1964.
