



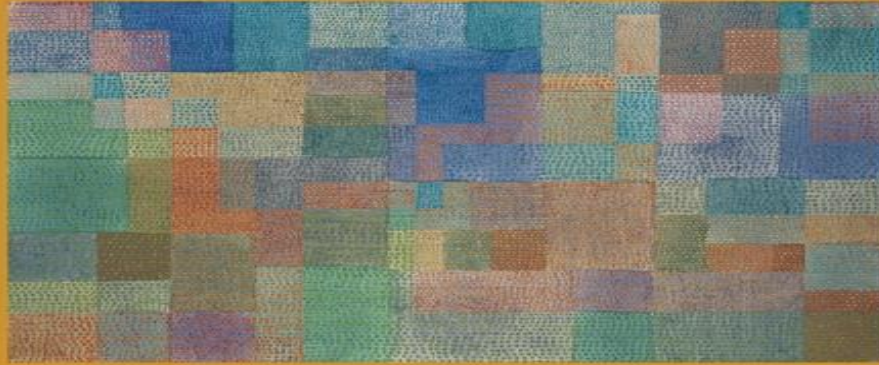

Plurality and European Memory
