The Interaction of US and Mexican Immigration Reform Processes and Increasing Migration through Mexico

Prof Rey Koslowski is Associate Professor of Political Science at the University of Albany, State University of New York. In this presentation, Prof Koslowski will examine the duelling US and Mexican immigration reform efforts of the past decade and explain how the US politics of immigration reform in 2005-2007 spurred Mexican legislators to liberalize Mexican immigration laws. He will also analyse how that reform had the unintended consequence of enabling increased migration through Mexico, a result that has a significant impact on current US debates on immigration.
