Davis, a prize-winning historian of early American history. In works such as *American Colonies: The Settling of North America* and his recent *The Civil War of 1812: American Citizens, British Subjects, Irish Rebels, & Indian Allies*, Professor Taylor looks across present-day borders to explore the transnational historical processes that shaped the development of the United States, Canada, and the rest of North America. His presentation on 8th May will begin at 4pm and will examine slavery in the Chesapeake region during the War of 1812. A reception hosted by the North American Studies Programme will follow in the Buttery at St Antony's College.
