The Suburbanisation of Arrival

In *Arrival City: How the Largest Migration in History is Reshaping Our World*, Doug Saunders examines the impact of the massive flow of rural people to urban areas, both within the nations of the developing world and from poorer countries to richer ones. He describes how these migrants moved through "arrival cities" -- particular neighbourhoods that, when successful, provided a pathway to integration into urban life. In this presentation, Saunders will describe how the "arrival cities" within US and Canadian metropolitan areas have in recent years moved to the suburbs, creating new obstacles to the incorporation of migrants into the life and economy of the broader community.
