Taught at the Institute for Contemporary Jewry at the Hebrew University. His academic work has focused on the study of the Holocaust with many

books and articles on the subject. Worked as Professor of Holocaust Studies at the Avraham

Harman Institute of Contemporary Jewry at the Hebrew University of Jerusalem.
