Born 1908, youngest child of Sir Eyre and Lady Crowe (née Clema Gerhardt). Educated Kensington High School; Girton College, Cambridge (Hist. Tripos 1928 & 1929), MA., Ph.D (Cantab.), Carlisle Research Scholar, Girton, 1937-1938. F.R.Hist.S.; Lecturer in Politics, St. Hilda's 1938-1941; Tutor, 1941-1975; Research Assistant, Foreign Office, 1942-1944; Foreign Office sponsored research into French Colonial Administration in North Africa, 1946-1948; Emeritus Fellow of St. Hilda's, 1975-1993. Died 15 April 1993.

Scope and content: File containing "Les droits électoraux des indigènes musulmans d'Algérie", typescript report on the legal status and rights of the indigenous Moslem population of Algeria with a review of various proposals for reform, 9 August 1939 and 13 boxes of presscuttings covering Morocco 1948-1956, Tunisia 1946-1953, French North Africa (in general) 1944-1952 and Middle East (in general) 1944-1952.
