Assistant Principal, Colonial Office, 1934; Private Sec. to Permanent Under-Secs of State for the Colonies, 1937; Malayan Civil Service, 1937-1942; RAF Intelligence Officer, 1942-1946; Prisoner of War in Japan, 1942-1945; attached to Colonial Office and accompanied Constitutional Comr. to Malta, 1946; Under-Sec. to Government of Palestine, 1946-1948; on UK Delegation to UN, 1948-1951; Colonial Sec. and at intervals Acting Governor Cyprus, 1951-1955; CMG 1952. Colonial Office, 1956; served in various roles in Tanganyika, 1956-1961. Knighted 1962. Visiting Professor (African Affairs), Univ. Colorado, 1961-1962, 1966 & 1973-1974. Contested (Cons.) Luton, Nov. 1963. MP (Cons.) Southampton Test, 1964-1966; membership of various international bodies and charitable organisations. Married1st (1936) Louise Brander (div. 1948) one son; 2nd (1949) Alice Egner (div. 1971) one son, one daughter; 3rd (1977) Marie-Louise, Vicomtesse Fournier de la Barre. Died 19 May 1989.
