Royal Engineers (T) Lieut., Royal Air Force (Flying Officer) 1915-19; Assistant Architect, Simla Imperial Circle, 1921-22; Assistant Architect, PWD, Hong Kong, 1923; Assistant Architect, Palestine 1929-37; F.R.I.B.A., 1933; Acting Architect, Palestine, 1937-38; Architect, Palestine, 1938-. Sergeant, Palestine Volunteer Force, 1942-43. Married - 2 children. Died 9 Oct 1989.

**Scope and content:** Papers on town-planning and public works in Palestine, 1933-1934, with some personal papers relating to his career, and a small amount of material relating to Hong Kong, 1921-1928.
