British Cadet Officer, Jerusalem District, Oct. 1934; Acting Assistant District Commissioner, Jerusalem District, 1935-1937; transferred to Galilee and Acre District, 1937. Married September 1938. Died in the bombing of the King David Hotel on 22 July 1946.

**Scope and content:** Short TS historical note on the city of Jerusalem with TS notes on procedures for policing the Easter and Nebi Musa celebrations in Jerusalem, 1947; parts of MS letters to his fiancée Joan, Feb-Aug. 1938.
