Counsellor at the Legation, Beirut, 1941-1942; Minister of State's Office, Baghdad and Cairo, 1942-1946; CMG; Counsellor, British Embassy, Cairo, 1947-1956. Retired 1957. Married, 1960, Noreen Hamilton-Wedderburn. Died 24 November 1973.
