Born 14 October 1904. M.A. (Cantab.). Student and Librarian, British School of Archaeology, Jerusalem; assisted at excavations at Ophel, 1928, Ajlun, 1929 and Meydum, Upper Egypt, 1929-1930; Field Archaeologist, Department of Antiquities, Palestine, 1930-1948. Married: 2 sons. Died 1992.

Scope and content: Letters from Nagib G. Nassar, Jerusalem, about the Jaffa riots, 1933, the work of the Dept. of Antiquities, 1935, and about finding work outside Jordan, 1952; copy of "Background notes: military and economic elements in the Israeli beach-head", 1970; four maps showing the proposed boundaries for the partition of Palestine, 1938; presscuttings on Palestine, 1923-1947.

Access conditions: Open

Language of material: English, small amount of Arabic

Conditions governing reproduction: No restrictions on copying or quotation other than statutory regulations and preservation concerns

Custodial history: In the possession of C.N. Johns and his family.
