Born 24 August 1880, son of Norman Lampson and Helen Lampson (née Blackburn). Educated Eton College. Entered Foreign Office, 1903; Secretary to Garter Mission, Japan, 1906; MVO 1906; 2nd Secretary, Tokyo, 1908-1910; Sofia, 1911; 1st Secretary, Peking, 1916; Acting British High Commissioner in Siberia, 1920; CMG 1922; CB 1926; British Minister to China, 1926-33; KCMG 1927; High Commissioner for Egypt and the Sudan, 1934-36; British Ambassador to Egypt and High Commissioner for the Sudan, 1936-46; GCMG 1937; PC 1941; created Baron 1943; Special Commissioner in South-East Asia, 1946-48. Married 1st, 1912, Rachel Phipps (died 1930): 1 son, 2 daughters; 2nd, 1934, Jacqueline Castellani: 1 son, 2 daughters. Died 18 September 1964.

Scope and content: 25 MS and TS volumes of diaries, 1926-51, covering his service in China, Egypt and the Sudan, and South-East Asia.

Language of material: English

Custodial history: In the possession of Lord Killearn, the Lampson family, Dr Trefor Evans and Dr David Steeds of the University of Aberystwyth.
