Born June 1910, son of Revd. A. Lloyd Phillips. Educated Worksop College; Selwyn College, Cambridge; Balliol College, Oxford (DPhil). Appointed Colonial Administrative Service, 1934; served Gold Coast, 1934-38; Palestine, 1938-47; District Commissioner, Gaza-Beersheba, 1946-47; Colonial Office, 1947-48; Cyprus, 1948-51; Commissioner, Nicosia-Kyrenia, 1950-51; Singapore, 1951-53; Commissioner-General's Office, 1951-52; Dep. Secretary for Defence, 1952-53; Malaya, 1953-62; Secretary to Chief Minister and Minister for Home Affairs, 1955-57; Secretary, Ministry of the Interior, 1957-62. OBE 1959; CBE 1963. Deputy Director, Oxford Colonial Records Project, Institute of Commonwealth Studies, Oxford University, 1965-70. Married, 1941, Faith Onslow: 1 son. Died 14 January 1984.
