Born 25 December 1911, only son of Lt-Col. C.E. Radclyff and Theresa Radclyffe (née Mott). Educated Eton College; Balliol College, Oxford. Added surname of Mott by deed poll, 1927. Hon. Attaché Diplomatic Service, Athens and Rome, 1936-1938; Mem. Military Mission to Greece, 1940-1941; Liaison Officer in Syria, 1941, and with Rifle Brigade in Middle East and Italy, 1943-1944; MP (Cons.) Windsor, 1942-1970; Parliamentary Private Sec. to Sec. of State for India, Dec.1944-May 1945; Junior Lord of the Treasury, May-July 1945; Conservative Whip, Aug. 1945-Feb. 1946; Chairman Conservative Party Foreign Affairs Committee, 1951-1959. Kt 1957. Member, Plowden Common on Overseas Representational Services, 1963-1964. Various appointments in Norfolk. Married 1) 1940, Diana Gibbs (died 1955): 3 daughters. 2) 1956, Stella Harrison. Died 25 November 1992.
