Born 1907, daughter of the Revd. W.A. Norman. Taught Maths at Jerusalem Girls' College 1934-1937; Head of Maths, Colchester High School, spring-term 1938; at St. Christopher's Training College, Blackheath, summer-term 1938; taught Maths at the English High School, Haifa, 1938-1943; taught Maths at Jerusalem Girls' College 1943-1948.

Scope and content: Letters written to her family in the course of her career as a mathematics teacher at Jerusalem Girls' College and the English High School, Haifa, 1934-1948, with some letters to her sister Evelyn while looking after St. George's Hostel, Jerusalem, in the absence of the Warden, Sept – Dec 1955.

System of arrangement: Chronological

Access conditions: Open

Language of material: English

Conditions governing reproduction: No restrictions on copying or quotation other than statutory regulations and preservation concerns

Custodial history: In the possession of the Norman family.

Immediate source of acquisition: Received from Dorothy Norman, February 1982, with the instruction that they were to be an outright gift on her death.
