Born 29 January 1885, son of Major William Price and Margaret Price (née Philips). Educated Harrow; Trinity College, Cambridge. Travelled in Central Asia, Siberia, Persia, Turkey, 1908-14; Liberal candidate for Gloucester (City), 1911-14; correspondent of Manchester Guardian in Russia, 1914-18; joined ILP and Labour Party, 1919; correspondent of Daily Herald in Berlin, 1919-23; Parliamentary Labour Party candidate for Gloucester (City) in General Elections of 1922,1923 and 1924; MP (Lab.) Whitehaven Division of Cumberland, 1929-31; Forest of Dean Division of Gloucestershire, 1935-50; West Division of Gloucestershire, 1950-59; PPS to Sir Charles Trevelyan, 1929-31; Forestry Commissioner, 1942-45; Parliamentary Charity Commissioner, 1945-50.

Married, 1919, Elisa Balster: 1 son, 1 daughter. Died 23 September 1973.
