Born 12 February 1931 in Cardiff. Educated Aberdare and Aberystwyth (Ardwyn) grammar school. Price Davies scholar to University College of Wales Aberystwyth 1949. Commissioned Royal Corps of Signals 1953; saw service in Malaya, Germany, Catterick and Cyprus. Attended Staff College Camberley 1963 followed by two year tour as Intelligence Staff Officer to the Federal Regular Army of South Arabia. Took part in the Radfan Campaign and incursions into Wadi Rabwa. After a tour as a squadron commander in the strategic reserve (3<sup>rd</sup> Division) he retired. Final posting as Signals Advisor to Libyan Army, working daily with Captain (later Major) Gadaffi. Took Postgraduate Certificate of Education (PGCE) at Oxford University and taught in two schools in Yorkshire. Head of Rougemont School, Newport for fifteen years then of two smaller schools; first Independent Schools Director for Wales, retiring in 2000. Published 'The Gaysh' 2004. Has since had three murder mysteries published.

Scope and content: Papers relating to the book 'The Gaysh' which is a history of the Aden Protectorate Levies 1927-1961 and the Federal Regular Army of South Arabia 1961-1967, including the typescript of 'The Gaysh' written in 1967-1968 with original photographs and a small amount of material from Frank Edwards' service in Aden c.1964-1965. There is also correspondence relating to the first attempt to publish 'The Gaysh' in 1968-1969, and correspondence and newspaper clippings relating to the publication and promotion of 'The Gaysh' in January 2004. There is a small amount of material relating to Frank Edwards' work with Colonel Gadaffi in the Libyan Army. The collection includes photocopies of photographs taken in Aden c.1948-1958 and a student exercise map of the Aden Protectorate, both given to Frank Edwards by Hugh Witherow in 2004.
