Biographical history: Ensor, Andrew Fisher (1918-2008)

Born 30 January 1918 in High Wycombe, son of R. C. K. Ensor, an Oxford historian and Fabian, and Helen Fisher. Educated at Winchester College and New College, Oxford. Served in the Army followed by the Royal Air Force during the Second World War. Took up employment with Standard Oil in 1949. Worked for America Independent Oil Co. in London from 1959 to 1966. From 1963 to 1966 he was the first US State Department Director of Fuel and Energy. From 1966 to 1978 he was London Director of the Middle East Office of Mobil Oil, where he negotiated oil prices with Middle Eastern leaders and politicians on behalf of a consortium of the world's seven largest oil companies. Subsequently he was a manager of a Mobil shipping office in Bermuda from 1978 to 1983, and an adviser to the White House and US Department of Defence on the oil industry and Middle Eastern affairs from 1983 to 1990. Married Joan Hepworth Rayner in 1948; two sons and two daughters. Died 4 March 2008.

**Scope and content:** Documents relating to Andrew F. Ensor's career in the oil industry in the 1940s-1970s, including correspondence, memoranda and internal company reports. Also includes a paper he wrote in 1979 about his dealings with OPEC leaders in the 1960s and early 1970s and notes on the book 'The Prize: the epic quest for oil, money, and power' by Daniel Yergin c1991.
