Biographical history: Giles, Peter (1929-2014) British Mandate Palestine Police Force.

Born 15 March 1929, son of Leslie Giles. 1946 enlisted through National Service, served in the Transjordanian Frontier Force as 2nd Lieutenant (Acting 1st Lieutenant 1 October 1947-1 December 1947). On 2 December 1947 he was transferred to the Palestine Police Force. He passed the Police Proficiency Course and Exam, and on 1 March 1947 was appointed as a British Constable [B/C], Service No. 2613, stationed at the Mustaspha Police Station. Demobilised at the end of the Palestine Mandate with the withdrawal of the British Administration. After working infrequently for the Melbourne Herald and Weekly Times, 1948-1952, he served in the Imperial Colonial Police in Fiji rising to the rank of Inspector and Acting Assistant Superintendent. Later worked in the area of road safety for the

Australian Government in Melbourne 1956-1962, then 1962-1969 in the travel industry,

including one attempted start-up. After 1969 moved into the area of Health Administration.

Married. Died 1 February 2014.

Scope and content: Papers, leaflets, photographs and artefacts collected during Peter Giles' time in the Transjordanian Frontier Force and the Palestine Police Force, mainly relating to his work as a police officer, including large numbers of Police and Legal Forms, both used and unused, and a number of Jewish and Arab propaganda leaflets and notices. There are also a small number of memoranda regarding the withdrawal of the British Administration and the future of its employees; two sections of editions of the Palestine Post, and an internal News Bulletin with updates on the situation in Palestine and various materials from Peter Giles' social and personal life, including prayer books, race programmes and telegrams.
