

Swire Postgraduate Scholarship - St Antony's College, University of Oxford

Eligibility	The Scholarship is restricted to permanent residents of Hong Kong, with excellent academic performance, along with clear personal aspirations and a strong drive to excel. The scholarship is offered to students who wish to read for any postgraduate degree in a subject offered by St Antony's College (see St Antony's College University of Oxford for a list of eligible courses).
Field(s) of Study	Full-time Master's or PhD degree in Humanities and Social Sciences
Tenure	Each scholarship is tenable for one year (Master's) or three years (PhD), subject to the nature of the course and continued satisfactory academic progress.
Coverage	Inclusive of the majority, if not all, of tuition fees, with additional living allowance, and travel stipend.
Application	Applicants are reminded to complete the course application with Oxford University directly, nominating St Antony's College as their first-choice college. For the Swire Scholarship application, please complete all required documents at this sharepoint, ensuring you include all necessary supporting documents, and email them to swirescholarships@jsshk.com. Please note that incomplete or incorrect information may lead to the disqualification of your application, or the withdrawal of any scholarship awarded. Only shortlisted candidates will be contacted for interview.
Documents Required	Mandatory Application Documents: • Application form*, • Latest resume*, • Personal statement*, • Latest academic transcript, • Most relevant diplomas or degree certificates (e.g., high school, bachelor's), • Two reference letters with letterhead of the school or institute they represent along with their contact information, the referees must include teaching staff of the institute you are attending currently, • A clear copy of your Identity Card (both sides) or Passport bio-data page. *Using the provided Swire Scholarships template.



Optional Supplementary Documents:

- School/university offer or admission letter.
- Proof of financial aid or need if applicable, such as:
 - An award letter from financial aid office,
 - Parents' or guardians' pay slips, tax returns, or bank statements, or
 - A sworn statutory declaration of family income.
- You may be required to present true copies of all the documents or letters upon request.
