Biographical history: Lloyd, Sir George Ambrose (1879-1941) 1st Baron Lloyd of Dolobran

Born 19 September 1879, son of S.S. Lloyd. Educated Eton College; Cambridge. Hon Attaché to HM Embassy at Constantinople; Special Commissioner for HMG on future of British trade in Turkey and Mesopotamia and Persian Gulf, 1908; Unionist MP for West Staffordshire, 1910-18; served European War in Egypt, Gallipoli, Mesopotamia and the Hejaz, 1914-18; DSO & CIE 1917; GCIE 1918; Governor of Bombay, 1918-23; Conservative MP for Eastbourne, 1924-25; PC & GCSI 1924; created Baron, 1925; High Commissioner for Egypt and the Sudan, 1925-29; President of the Navy League, 1930; Chairman British Council, 1936; Secretary of State for the Colonies, 1940-41. Married, 1911, Hon Blanche Lascelles: 1 son. Died 4 February 1941.

Scope and content: Letters written from Sir George Lloyd in Egypt to his sister Mrs. Gwen Carleton, 1900-1901, 1905-1907 and 1910; two personal letters to Major General F.S. Piggott, May 1940.
